Mr. Brandt Rydell (incumbent) received 304 votes and Mr. Miguel Espitia received 124 votes.

Mayor Pro Tem Gonzales moved to approve the resolution as presented declaring Mr. Rydell re-elected to the District 3 position and Council Member Hill seconded the motion. VOTE: Five voted AYE. Motion passed.

Judge Randall Pick, Taylor Municipal Court, administered the oath of office to both Mr. Rydell and Mr. Gonzales. Mr. Gonzales had run unopposed and was declared elected at the March 12, 2015 council meeting.

3. ELECT A MAYOR.

Mr. Hejl issued a call for nominations for Mayor. Council Member Green moved to elect Council Member Ancira as Mayor. Mayor Pro Tem Gonzales called for nominations be closed. VOTE: Five voted AYE. Motion passed.


4. ELECT A MAYOR PRO TEM


