

- I. CALL TO ORDER AND DECLARE A QUORUM – Chairman Stone declared the meeting to order at 5.03 pm and noted that a quorum was present.
- II. PUBLIC COMMENT – No public comments
- III. REVIEW / DISCUSS AND CONSIDER ACTION ON THE FOLLOWING:

There are different platforms where Artist Calls can be listed – CallforArtists.com and AnyArtists.com are less expensive. Casey noted that there are fees charged for listing projects but she did not have any specifics for the board at that time. FY 2023 BUDGET RECOMMENDATION

According to the most recent financial report (from October), approximately \$5,500.00 remains in the FY 2023 budget.

Propose that the Taylor Public Arts Advisory Board allocate \$3,500 to light Potters Alley.

Propose that the PAAB allocate \$500 as a contingency to cover unexpected expenses.

Options for the remaining \$1,500:

1. Commission a public art project along the northern reach of the hike and bike trail (perhaps under the Main Street bridge along the hike and bike trail, much like Potters Alley ... organic "street art").
