



Celebrate the holiday season and create your one-of-a-kind shoebox float for Taylor Public Library's Virtual Shoebox Parade

Eligibility:

Open to traditional parade participants (businesses, schools, churches, clubs, community organizations, and municipal departments) and families!

Guidelines & Restrictions:

- Limit one entry per group. EXCEPTION: Schools or municipalities may have multiple entries if representing distinct clubs and/or departments.
- Your float can be made from a traditional cardboard shoebox or similar structure (be creative). Only restriction is that it should be no larger than 10" x 13" and limited only by your imagination.
- Entries should not exceed 20" in height or weigh more than 10 lbs.
- Do not use wheels or build floats on a truck body, motorized toy or a base larger than the shoebox.
- Floats must be appropriate for a family audience and avoid controversial themes or issues. Use of political or social material is prohibited.
- If your entry exceed the size limitations, it may be disqualified from contest but included in the exhibition. Affix entry card to the bottom of the float.
