

2019 INFRASTRUCTURE BOND STREET RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT YOUR BOND DOLLARS AT WORK

In Fiscal Year 2019, the City of Taylor approved \$13.1 million in bond funds for infrastructure improvements.

The Taylor Street Project includes safety, mobility and connectivity improvements for five substandard streets. Construction began in July 2020. Work is almost complete at Lake Drive and Carlos Parker Blvd. All five streets are expected to be completed by the Summer of 2021.



KEEPING YOU INFORMED.
